Specifications:

- Seven (7) Diamond North Credit Union Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 are **available to Grade 12 students who are members of Diamond North Credit Union** (as of January 1st, 2024)
- Each recipient is limited to one (1) \$1,000.00 scholarship. Scholarships will not necessarily be awarded if none of the applicants meet the specified requirements.
- Selection will be made by the Diamond North Credit Union Scholarship Committee on the basis of **leadership, community involvement, extra-curricular activity, and academic achievement**.
- Where possible, awards will be presented at recipients' graduation ceremonies.
- Scholarships must be used for an approved post-secondary school course and payment will be subject to proof of acceptance from the student's chosen institution. Award may be claimed up to 16 months from the date the scholarship is announced. A request for extension may be submitted.
- Applying for this award indicates your permission to use your name and photo on Diamond North Credit Union's website, social media pages, newsletters etc.

Required Documentation:

- **Completed** application form.
- **A copy of your Saskatchewan Ministry of Education Transcript**, which includes first semester marks of your Grade 12 year.
- A school provided copy of your **2nd semester marks** up until your application date signed by your Guidance Counsellor or Principal
- **Letter of character reference** from someone other than a relative supporting your community and/or school involvement.
